Each day a sweet surprise.


Mix in fond appreciation For the people whom we know; Like festive Christmas candles, Each one has a special glow.

ANGEL DELIGHTS

1/4 cup unsalted butter

1 cup sugar

1 1/2 cups (8 ounces) chopped pitted dates

1/8 teaspoon salt

1 teaspoon vanilla extract

2 cups toasted rice cereal (such as Rice Krispies)

1 cup shredded coconut

Combine butter, sugar and dates in a large saucepan. Cook, stirring constantly, until the butter is melted, the sugar is no longer white and the dates are mostly melted, 8 to 15 minutes. The mixture should be a shiny, brown sticky mass. Remove from the heat.

Add salt, vanilla, cereal and coconut; sir well to combine.

When cool enough to handle, squeeze and roll the mixture into 1-inch balls. Place on a wax paperlined baking sheet. Refrigerate until chilled.
