It was reported that the 2 additional park style benches have been installed and that project is complete.

The welcome wagon has several homes that need to be welcomed. Tim and Joe will take care of the within the next two weeks.

Keith reported that the holding ponds are to be cut one final time by the county for the season and there are plans to fence some of them in.

The topic of the front entrance sign was discussed. The general opinion was to forgo the entrance sign. A motion to table the front entrance sign was approved.
